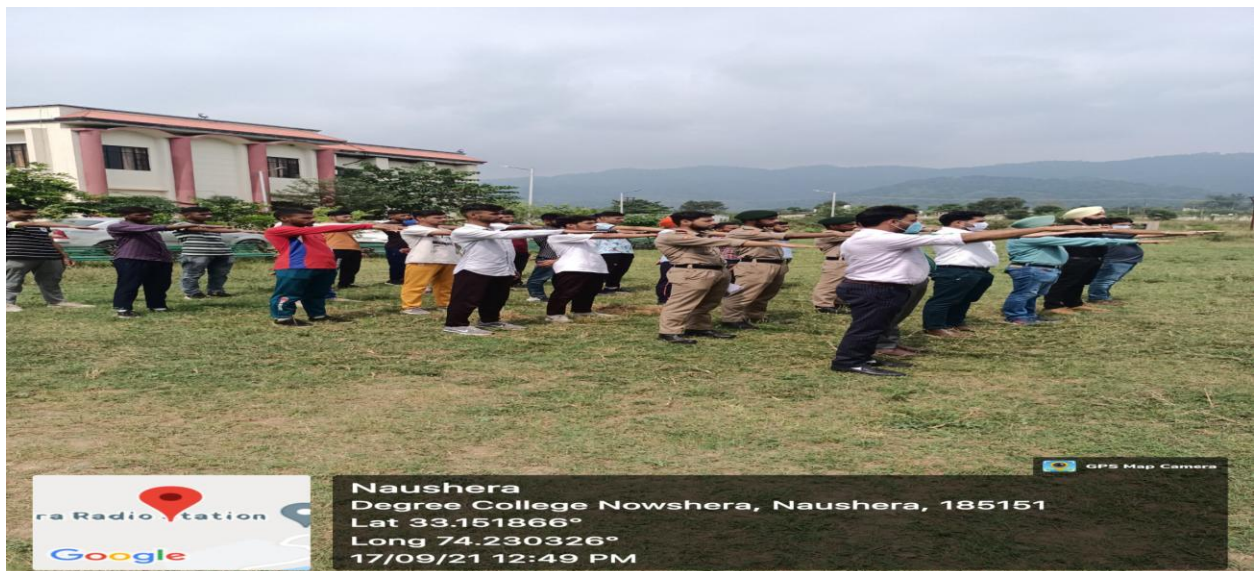

The competition was Bilingual and the participants were asked to submit their

essay within the time period of three days. Within the time limit organizer has received 35 entries from all over UT. The main aim of essay writing competition was to realize the impact we have on biodiversity because without it there would be no human existence.

Sanjana Sharma of GDC Nowshera bagged first position while Israr Ahmed of GDC Mendhar and Ashish Singh of GDC Nowshera secured 2nd and 3rd positions respectively.

While appreciating the event Principal of the college

Dr. Surinder Kumar said that COVID-19 is a zoonosis, i.e., a disease that is transmitted from animal to human but the reason of major outbreak of such zoonotic diseases is associated with the increasing loss of natural habitat. Outbreaks like Ebola and HIV also emerged from areas where bio diverse habitats of our planet were disappearing.

The valuable lesson we need to learn from these pandemics is that we are a part of the ecosystem where our health is linked to the health of wildlife and the

health of their environment. Let us not double the risk by creating conditions that favour pandemics and by minimizing the chances of finding a cure against ‘invisible’ enemy due to biodiversity loss. So it is a time now to join hands and respond to this wake-up call collectively, adapt to the ways of Sustainable Development and adopt biodiversity as our defensive weapon against any future pandemic that can devastate not only Man but also humanity.
