The Red Ribbon Club, GDC Nowshera celebrated "WORLD AIDS DAY".

World AIDS Day remains as relevant today as it has always been, reminding people and governments that HIV has not gone away. There is still a critical need for spreading awareness among the people to end the stigma and discrimination against the HIV infected persons. Keeping the same thought in mind, Red Ribbon Club, GDC Nowshera in collaboration with J&K AIDS Control Society, Department of Health & Medical Education and Higher Education Department, J&K organized a couple of activities to celebrate the World AIDS Day, 2022 with the theme **"Equalise: Achieving Equity to End HIV/AIDS".** Dr. K.K. Sharma, Principal of the college was the Chief Guest on this occasion.

The programme started with Welcome Address by Prof. Pooja Devi, Nodal Officer, Red Ribbon Club. She welcomed worthy Principal and other faculty members present on the occasion. While addressing the gathering, Prof. Pooja Devi threw light on the history and significance of celebration of World AIDS Day and laid focus to end the HIV/AIDS Stigma in the society.
